



Greetings from the Akimel O'odham/Pee-Posh Youth Council!

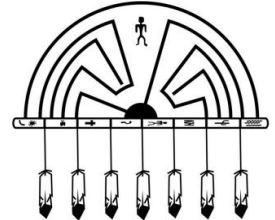

Applicants must present a brief description (50 words or less) of workshop along with application. The description will be put into the agenda.

Youth-led workshops are encouraged and will be given preference.

Workshops will be 45 minutes in length and you may be asked to present more than one session.
