MINOR/ADULT TRUST TERMINATION MANDATORY FINANCIAL LITERACY REQUIREMENT

In order to qualify for your trust distribution, you must complete a Mandatory Council-Approved Financial Literacy Course recently approved by Ordinance GR-004-23.

TO COMPLETE THIS FINANCIAL LITERACY COURSE, THERE ARE TWO OPTIONS:
