







For those GRIC Employees who work outdoors: below are a few safety tips:

- Thunderstorms can produce strong gusty winds and winds can cause property damage.

- Heavier showers will create hazardous driving conditions. Be sure to check vehicle wiper blades and tires.
- If you come across barricades blocking off a flooded section of the road, DON'T try to drive around them. Turn around and find a detour. It's closed for a reason.

The weather today will be sunny then will have a slight chance for thunderstorms tonight. Tuesday will be mostly sunny with a high of 109 degrees and will have a low of 87 degrees. Wednesday will be hot with a high of 110 degrees and will have a low of 86 degrees. Thursday will have a 20 percent slight chance for thunderstorms and will have a low of 85 degrees. Friday going into the weekend will be mostly sunny with highs in the 100's with lows in the 80's and Sunday will have a slight chance for thunderstorms.
