- Cut or trim low-hanging tree limbs that pose the danger of falling during rain and windstorms.
- Inspect your home surroundings for drainage issues.
- Secure outside furniture, garbage cans and any other property that can move during strong wind.
- Avoid flooded roadways. Turn Around. Don't Drown! Just six inches of fast-moving water can knock you down, and one foot of moving water can sweep your vehicle away.
- Watch for fallen power lines and trees. Report them immediately.
- Check on members who may require special assistance, such as infants, children and the elderly or disabled
