## Bulk Refuse-2025



The Gila River Indian Community, Department of Public Works (DPW) will continue to provide pickup of Bulk Trash, items too big to fit in a regular trash container. A Work Order is required from DPW Customer Service Desk (520-562-3343) on/or before Friday 4:30pm prior to your designated week. Bulk Trash must be on the curb Sunday evening of your collection week. Place your bulk items at least 5 feet away from your regular trash container, as long as it does not cover any utility meters in the area. If your alley is accessible, place the items there. Pick-up dates listed for your area on this announcement.

Bulk Trash Work Orders are based on the priority list for pickup during your designated week and the number of work orders submitted for that week. If your Bulk Trash is not picked up during your cycle, please call our office to be placed on the priority list for the next cycle. DPW concentrates on the populated areas and subdivisions first, so if you live outside these areas in the scattered housing, a longer pickup time may be required. Per the illustration, a 4-yard bulk trash limit will be enforced in order to provide uniform service coverage to the entire Gila River Indian Community.

Restricted Trash: DPW will not pick up household hazardous materials such as motor oil, paint and batteries. For the disposal of these items, please call Department of Environmental Quality, (520) 562-2234.

Gila River Indian Community residents may haul their own garbage and bulky items to the transfer station at no charge. Proof of residency is required at the transfer station, located at Casa Grande Road and South Canal (old landfill). Open Monday through Saturday, 6:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., closed on Sunday and some Holidays. You must show a photo ID and a current Gila River Indian Community utility bill.

Another available option is to rent a large container for your own use. Details and pricing are available by calling our department. Scheduling these types of containers is encouraged to be at least one week prior to needing them.
